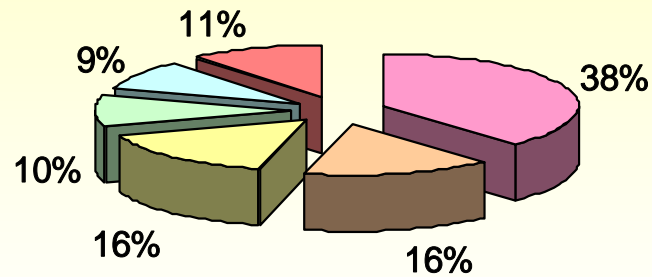

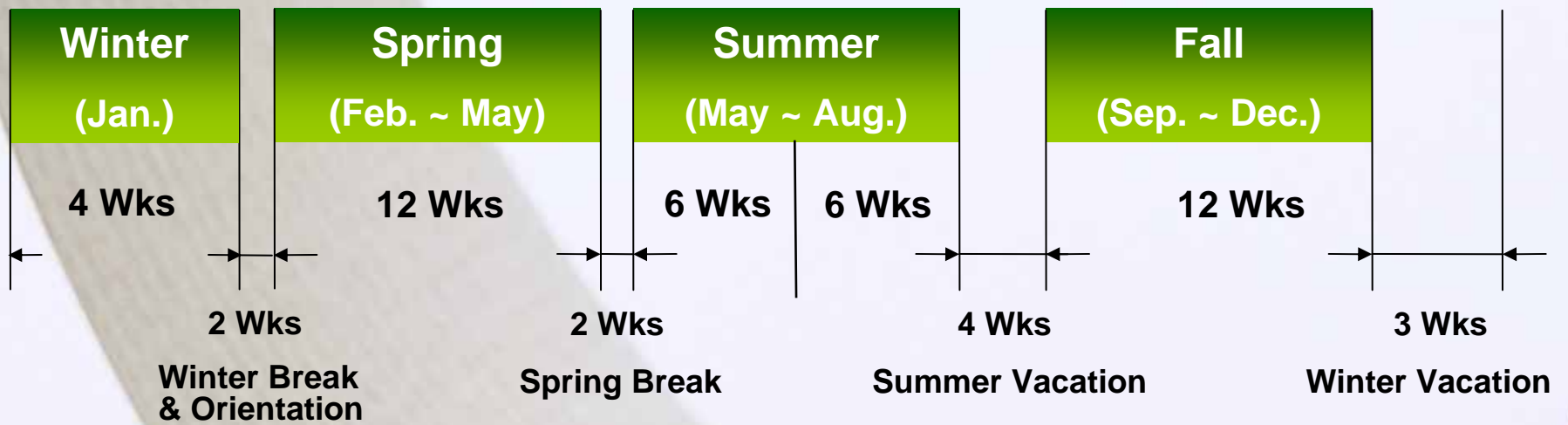

Trimester System



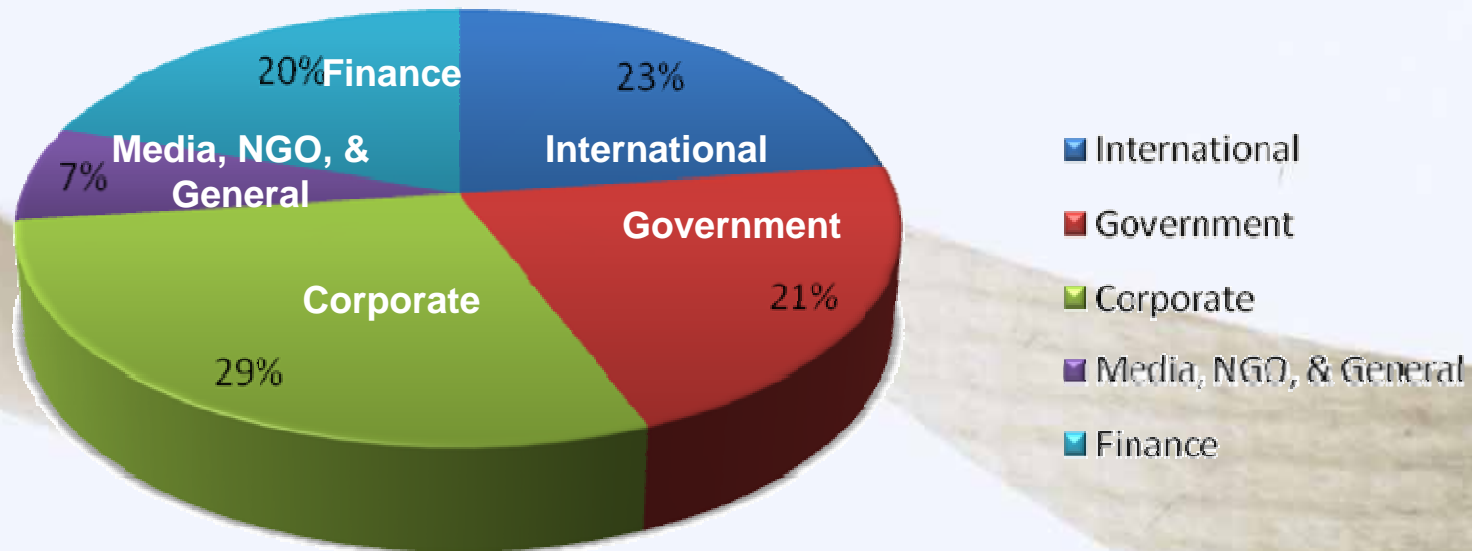
